The Teen and YA Program has expanded and is now providing ongoing after school programs three days a week. We have also added Saturday options for younger children. The need for programs for this age group continues to grow. Data shows that young people who have the opportunity to participate in programs that promote independence and inclusion together we change lives and connect are more likely to experience a greater level of independence in adulthood.

Staffing is a concern nationwide and we have also felt that issue. Our DSP's are amazing and their heart for those we support is outstanding. Our work remains incredibly important. There is no better feeling than knowing that people with purpose.

OUR PROGRAMS

Residential Supports Staffed Residences

-provide 24 hour supervision for individuals living in a home. Typically three (3) individuals live together in the residences. Supported Apartments/Living -provides support on an intermittent basis for individuals living in their own apartment.

Employment Services—For those individuals who are interested in finding meaningful employment opportunities as well as earn a paycheck, Dreams With Wings offers both job development and on the job coaching services.

Behavioral/Therapy Services—Clinicians provide behavior, OT, PT and Speech services to adults and children. Services occur on site in the adult day program and in home based on therapist availability.

Adult Day Services — The Dream Builders program enhances daily living skills, communication and social skills through community interaction and onsite activities. The goal is to create a meaningful day that is choice driven by each individual.

Community Living Services (CLS) and Respite Services -CLS is provided to individuals at home or in the community. Individuals are matched with support staff and together they work 1:1 on independent living skills.

Teen Education Program—Expanded opportunity for teens to develop social and independent learning skills, leading to inclusion and a higher quality of life for those with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Two seven week summer camps enhance daily skills while having fun and making friends.


